### General Guidelines for Funding Consideration

Applications will be considered on a case by case basis. Broadly speaking, applicants will fall into one of four groups:

1: Large charities with national organizations and/or with their own large public fund-raising activities.

These requests should have a specific project/equipment/event/need to which our funding would be directed. We would expect recognition for our donation specifically to that project.

2: Small local charities or local branches of national organizations that do not receive national funding and rely primarily on local fund-raising activities.

Funding is primarily member generated or generated by a special interest support group such as parents. A specific project/purchase/event would be preferred in these cases.

3: Club projects.

This refers to our current Fort Amherst project and other Legacy projects as well as other specific applicants sponsored by the Club Board.

4: Individual requests for help.

This refers to contributions to individuals under categories including, but not restricted to, student exchange, special medical assistance, special requests from agencies such as the RNC, RCMP, etc. Donations would be in the range of \$100 to \$500 with a maximum of \$1,000 in total donations per quarter.

Again broadly speaking, we will not consider funding where religious, political or sports funding is the primary focus of the request.
